The Lord's Prayer...

Matthew 6:5-15

Pray then like this:

"Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name.[a] <sup>10</sup> Your kingdom come, your will be done,[b] on earth as it is in heaven.

- 11 Give us this day our daily bread,[9]
- 12 and forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors.
- 13 And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.[d]

<sup>14</sup> For if you forgive others their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you, <sup>15</sup> but if you do not forgive others their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses."

**Responding-** Is us acting, responding in obedience.
