"God is the source."

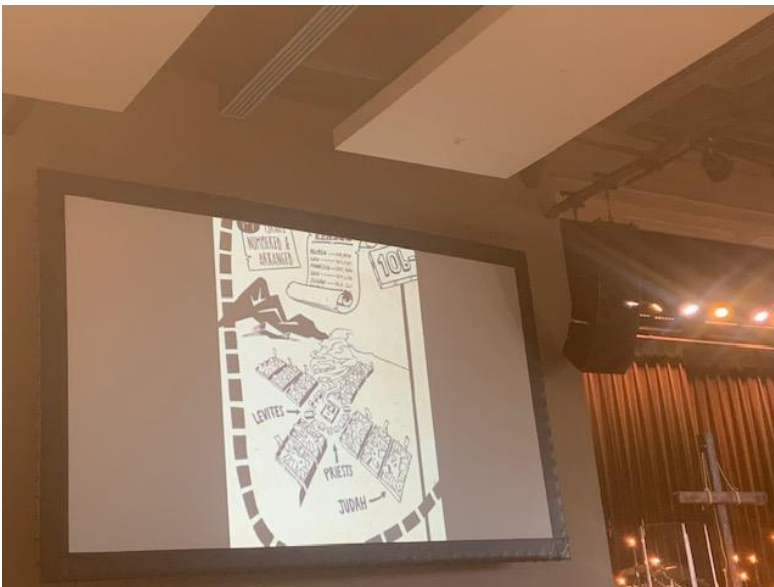
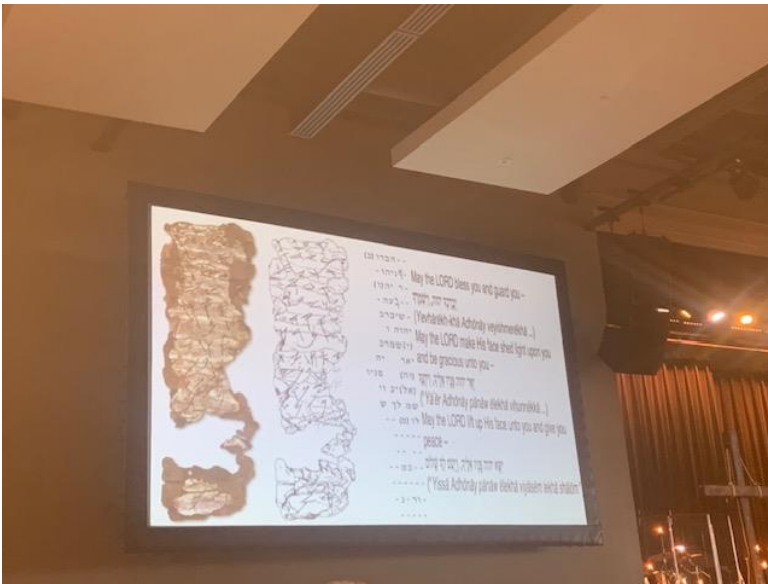
"The word Keep is worth keeping in mind. Because the Lord alone is "KEEPER."
