### Other, Key quotes; points and questions to reflect on and discuss from Justine's message:

#### Couple of Key Points:

Jesus fulfills Old Testament sacrificial laws not by animals, but through Himself, once for all.

His sacrificial death is the culmination of God's covenant faithfulness.

#### Key Quotes:

- "Jesus is the perfect sacrifice—not another offering, but **the** offering."
- "The sacrificial system was never intended to end in itself—it was pointing ahead."
- "When we internalize Jesus as our sacrifice, it changes our identity, our hope, our calling."
