Key Questions...

- 1). Why do you think the crowd expected a political savior rather than humble and righteous leader like Jesus? What does this reveal about human nature?
- 2). When you hear the word “king,” what characteristics come to mind? How does Jesus challenge those expectations?
- 3). In what ways might we sometimes want Jesus to solve external problems while ignoring the deeper problem of sin and pride in our own hearts?
- 4). Where do you see pride affecting your relationships, leadership, or decision-making?
- 5). What would it look like this week to practice the humility of Jesus in your home, work, or church?
